



## Psychotherapy Department

APsaA's Psychotherapy Department serves as an umbrella for a variety of activities related to psychoanalytic psychotherapy. These include supporting educational meetings and continuing education related to psychotherapy at the APsaA national meetings. The Psychotherapy Department also functions as a liaison between local psychotherapy training programs and the national organization. It supports outreach to psychotherapists and provides educational opportunities through ongoing discussion groups and workshops at the national meetings. Additionally, it promotes the growth and development of psychodynamic psychotherapy training programs.

### **Mission of the Department:**

- To promote psychoanalytic psychotherapy as an integral dimension of psychoanalysis.
- To strengthen the interface between the two modes of therapy in terms of theory, education, practice and identity.

*The Psychotherapy Department consists of the following Committees:*

**Psychotherapy Department Advisory Committee:** The Committee serves as an umbrella function for the Department in organizing and overseeing activities within the Association and outreach beyond the Association. The Committee is chaired by the Department Co-Chairs and is comprised of the committee chairs of all constituent Department Committees (Psychotherapist Associates, Committee on Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy Training Programs, Psychotherapy E-Newsletter Editor) and additional involved parties. The functions of the Committee include serving in an advisory capacity to the Department Co-Chairs in relation to the Department's business and new initiatives; working as a planning group for new projects and initiatives; and providing the oversight for new initiatives and outreach. Newcomers interested in getting involved but are unsure where to begin are most welcome to attend a Committee meeting.

**Committee on Psychotherapist Associates:** A Committee whose goal is to represent the interest of those affiliated with APsaA as a Psychotherapist Associate (PA's), to coordinate Psychotherapist Associate sponsored events at the annual meetings, and to offer assistance to local psychotherapy programs. The Committee works to promote the activities of APsaA's Psychotherapist Associates to an expanding group of psychotherapists.

- **Two - Day Clinical Workshop: Psychotherapy Technique and Process** - Offers participants an unusual opportunity to investigate the process of psychoanalytic psychotherapy in depth.
