ISSUES RESOLUTION REGARDING MISUSE
OF PSYCHIATRIC HOSPITALIZATION

New York, January --: At the Meeting of Members of the American Psychoanalytic Association, held in New York City on December 18th, 1971, the following was resolved:

The American Psychoanalytic Association,
in keeping with its concerns for standards
of ethical conduct, deplors the misuse of
psychiatric hospitalization as a political
device wherever and whenever this occurs.
We encourage our members to inform themselves
of such activities in order to be able to
effectively express their concern.
